

The Gospel of Matthew Chapter 10:21-42

A. Review

1. Jesus summoned His twelve apostles and gave them __ N S __ R __ __ T I __ N.
2. The apostles were to __ __ A L the sick and cast out unclean __ P I __ __ T S.
3. Jesus instructed the apostles to first seek the “lost sheep of __ S R __ E __” and then the Gentiles.
4. The apostles were warned that they would face P E __ __ E C __ T __ O N because of their teachings.

B. Widespread Persecution (Matt 10:21-25)

1. Jesus warns that religious differences would D __ __ I __ E families.
2. Jesus instructs the apostles to “F __ __ E” if a city persecutes them.
3. The apostles are told not to expect better T __ __ A T __ __ N __ than Jesus.

C. Do Not Fear Man (Matt 10:26-28)

1. Jesus assures the apostles that all will be “__ E __ E A __ E __.”
2. All people will be held __ C C __ __ N T __ B L __ for their actions.
3. Man is limited in his abilities, but __ O __ is The Almighty.
4. We should fear punishment from God more than punishment from man.

D. We Are Valued (Matt 10:29-31)

1. Jesus uses an example of a __ P A __ __ O __ to explain our value to God.
2. God knows all, including the number of __ A __ __ S on our head.

E. Our Task (Matt 10:32-33)

1. Jesus instructs us to __ O N F __ __ __ His name before men.
2. We are to share the Good News and help others turn to Jesus.

F. The Cost of Our Task (Matt 10:34-42)

2. We must decide what is most important: __ O Y __ L __ Y to family or eternity in Heaven.
3. We are told to take up our “C __ O S __” and continue our journey for Christ.
