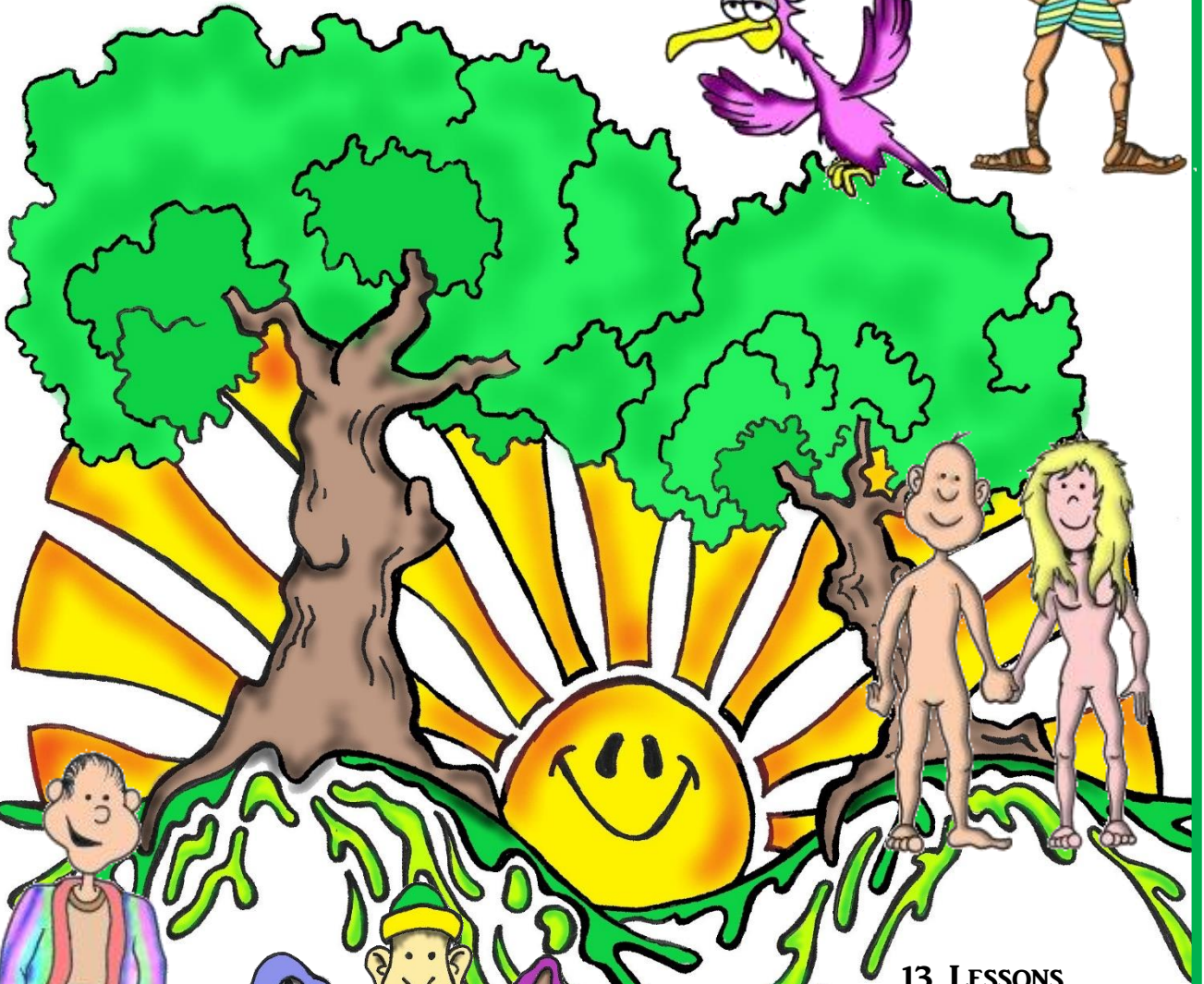

Worksheet questions are taken from the text of the New King James Version of the Bible.

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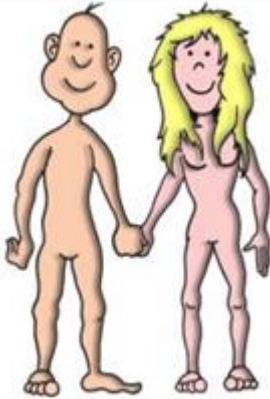
